We invite you to participate in the II International Scientific and Practical Internet Conference of Young Scientists "Economic Development of the State, Regions, and Enterprises: Problems and Prospects" to be held on the **18-19th of May, 2017**.

To participate in the conference we invite young scientists up to 35 years (at least one of the authors must meet this criterion), among which are lecturers, researchers, postgraduates, PhD, Doctor of Sciences, experts on economics and management, who work at enterprises, organizations and institutions, representatives of local authorities involved in the solution of economic problems, professionals.

CONFERENCE SESSIONS:

1. Problems and prospects of the economic development of Ukraine under conditions of European integration;
2. Influence of external and internal factors on the economic development of the regions;
3. Complex support of the enterprise economic development;
4. Strategic management of the innovative development at macro- and micro-levels;
5. Balanced development of the Ukrainian economy: social and legal, ecological, and other aspects.

FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONFERENCE:

By May 5, 2017 you must submit online an application for participation, which is filled on the website www.science.inem.lviv.ua and send an abstract (a file should be named as a surname of a first author in Latin, for example: Vakiv_tezy.doc) and a scanned original document on payment of the registration fee (for example, Vakiv_oplata.jpg) on e-mail: conf-rmv-inem@ukr.net.

REGISTRATION FEE:

For inclusion of the abstracts in the proceedings of the conference, Ukrainian participants must pay the conference fee:
- 80 UAH per 1-2 complete pages of text;
- each additional page: 20 UAH.
For foreign participants of the conference the fee is 20 USD.

Details for the payment of the registration fee will be sent after acceptance of the abstracts.

REQUIREMENTS TO THE SUBMISSION OF ABSTRACTS:

Abstracts: 1-2 complete pages. If it is necessary, you can submit abstracts of a larger volume for an extra charge (they should be not larger than 7 complete pages).

You must adhere to the following requirements of composition: a font – 12 pt, a space – 1, an indent – 1 cm, a font is Times New Roman. A format of sheets - A4 (210x297mm). Margins: from the left side – 30 mm, from the right side - 20 mm. Do not insert page numbers.

References must be submitted in compliance with the existing bibliographic requirements. References for literature in the text are put in square brackets, for instance [3, p.10]. The use of illustrative materials in the abstracts should be minimal. All the figures should be grouped as a single object.

The organizing committee reserves the right to partial edition or rejection of abstracts that do not meet the requirements.

The conference participants directly attending in the conference will receive certificates. In the process of the conference there will be round-table discussions dedicated to the solution of problems of young scientists, the development and cooperation of councils of young scientists in Ukraine, and the implementation of scientific results in activities of enterprises, local authorities, and the state power, etc. There will also be other interesting events for young scientists.

REQUIREMENTS TO THE MATERIALS OF THE MONOGRAPH:

1. Materials should have a logical structure: problem and its links with scientific and practical tasks; analysis of recent research and publications with links to the references; unsolved aspects of the problem; forming research purposes (problem); the main part of the study (with justification of scientific results); conclusions and prospects of the further research in this area.

2. The paper should have 20-30 pages.
3. Margins: top, bottom, right, left – 20 mm.
4. Headset: a font – Times New Roman 14 pt, a space – 1.5, an indent – 1 cm.
5. Language: Ukrainian and English.

Materials should be sent to the email address of the organizing committee conf-rmv-inem@ukr.net, indicating the subject "Monograph: the author's name".

The cost of the publication of materials in monograph is **40 USD** (for foreign authors), **30 UAH** per 1 complete / incomplete page of A4 format (for Ukrainian authors). Details for payment will be sent on author's email after the materials for publication will be approved.
